

## E-Health Requirements for New Pharmacies

### E-Health – Joint Service Access and Policy (JSAP) for New Pharmacy Establishment

**Read and Sign the Joint Service Access and Policy (JSAP):** Prior to a new store opening, the Pharmacy Managers must read and accept the terms of the Joint Service Access and Policy (JSAP\*). The steps to follow:

1. Read the JSAP on the PIP website (<https://pip.ehealthsask.ca/>)
2. Print and sign the JSAP Confirmation of Receipt and Acceptance on eHealth Saskatchewan's (eHS) website (<http://www.ehealthsask.ca/forms>).

**Note:** Written signatures are only accepted and the organization specified should be the same name as entered on the SPP Online Permit Amendment Application

**PIP Integration as of Opening Day:** The Ministry of Health's Pharmaceutical Information Program (PIP) CeRx integration project is approaching its completion. It is the Ministry's expectation that each Saskatchewan pharmacy that intends to submit claims to the Drug Plan in 2015-16 will be integrated to PIP using the national CeRx electronic messaging standard by March 31, 2015. As a result, all new pharmacies must integrate to PIP as of their opening day.

The completion of PIP CeRx integration will support the use of PIP information by healthcare providers in all patient care settings. It will also enable future phases of the Saskatchewan electronic health record to be scheduled and implemented.
