

SCPP Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy applies to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacy Professionals (SCPP) websites, connected services provided to you by SCPP ("SCPP", "we", "our" or "us") that post a direct link to SCPP Privacy Policy (the "Services").

By accessing and using our Services, you are agreeing to the terms of this Cookie Policy and our <u>Privacy Policy</u>. Please read this Cookie Policy and our <u>Privacy Policy</u> carefully so you know what we are doing with your information. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO EITHER THE PRIVACY POLICY OR THIS COOKIE POLICY YOU MAY NOT USE SCPP SERVICES.

COOKIES

SCPP may use cookies and web beacons on certain areas of our Services. Cookies are small text files that we may store on your computer or device to remember certain things about your use of our Services. This Cookie Policy describes the categories of cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them and how you can change your preferences.

We use the following types of cookies on our Services:

Strictly Necessary Cookies. These types of cookies enable you to request and receive information or services from our Services.

Performance Cookies. Performance cookies enable us to analyze the performance and design of our Services and detect errors. For example, this type of cookie allows us to recognize repeat visitors to our website and show which section of the website are accessed most frequently and how much time visitors spend on each page.

Functional Cookies. These cookies allow us to enhance and personalize your experience. For example, we may use these to identify the content you previously viewed on SCPP website or device profile name you created when registering on our website.

FLASH COOKIES

We may also use local shared objects, otherwise known as flash cookies. Flash cookies are similar to the cookies discussed above in that they are stored on your computer and can be used to store certain information about your activities and preferences or to display content, such as videos. However, these objects are stored in different parts of your computer from ordinary browser cookies.

Disabling/Enabling Cookies on Your Browser

Most web browsers allow you to modify your settings to block cookies entirely, alert you every time they are being sent or allow their use by only those websites you approve. You can also delete cookies that are currently stored on your computer's hard drive. To do this, look for the cookie control settings in your web browser (usually under Tools, Options/Internet Options, Privacy/Security tab) and then make your desired selections. If you choose to disable cookies, certain features of the Services may not be available or work properly.

Disabling Flash Cookies
